Strengths:

- Follows ECU university policy for syllabi outline.
- Well organized. The evaluation and grading is manageable and can be easily maintained.
- Includes the relevant standards from Section II and from the 2009 sections for Clinical Mental Health and School Counseling.
- Assignments/assessments support student learning and development which expose students to the introductory components relevant to counseling.

Areas for consideration/improvement:

- I would suggest removing the specific term, CRN and dates from the syllabus so that it is a general syllabus.
- It may be helpful to write out the specific Standards that are addressed in addition to the citation (e.g. II.G.1.c : counselors roles and responsibilities.....) this shows the precise alignment with the specific assignment.
