Recourse for Student Appealing a Grade

Procedure: Instructor; Department Chair; Departmental Committee. Appeals from the Committee's decision may be made on procedural grounds only and must be made within 20 days following notification of the departmental committee decision. Such an appeal should be made to the Dean of the college in which the course is offered and, if necessary, then to the Vice-President for Academic Affairs and Research.

Recourse in the Event of Other Institutional Failure

If a student believes there has been some type of breach of policy not covered in the "Recourse for Student Appealing a Grade" section, the student should first attempt to resolve the matter with the person most directly involved. If the student is unable to gain satisfaction at this point, or if the matter so justifies, the student should register a detailed complaint, oral or written with the immediate supervisor of the person in question

In the event that satisfaction is not obtained, following established procedure, the student or faculty member may make a full report to the dean of the college or head of the other administrative unit and/or the Vice-President for Academic and Research

Each department in the Professional Education Unit has an initial and an advanced Program Assessment and Curriculum Committee (DPACC) whose actions are directed at the departmental level. In some cases, the members of these two committees may be the same. The DPACC is the assessment and curriculum alignment agent for each of the Initial and Advanced programs within the Professional Education Unit. Each DPACC is responsible for assessing the efficiency and effectiveness of each program, and for ensuring that all relevant data are summarized in the program level Key Assessment Summary Reports. Summarized Assessment data are gathered from all program stakeholders including, professional education candidates, faculty and staff of the COE and other colleges in the professional education unit, cooperating teachers and principals, formal surveys and interviews, standardized tests, other formal assessment results, and informal recommendations from the field.

Data inputs for **all programs** are analyzed consolidated by program recorded on Program level Key Assessment summary reports and entered into TRACDAT by **August 15** for the previous year's data.

The current policy on P & T states that the College will elect a representative for the college (two year appointment) and two alternatives (one year appointments) to serve on the University P&T committee no later than May of the year preceding their service. We normally elect a two year representative and the two, one year alternatives but because of several issues that arose this year we will be electing representative for all of these terms with one of the two year terms only getting a one year appointment. Each department must submit one nomination for these four positions and then a college wide election will be held with the top vote getter being the 2 year representative, then the one year representative, then the two one year alternatives. This requires that the Representatives must hold the Rank of Professor or the highest rank available in the department to serve. Representatives can't be chairs or deans and, once elected, can't serve on college or department P&T committees during their terms.
